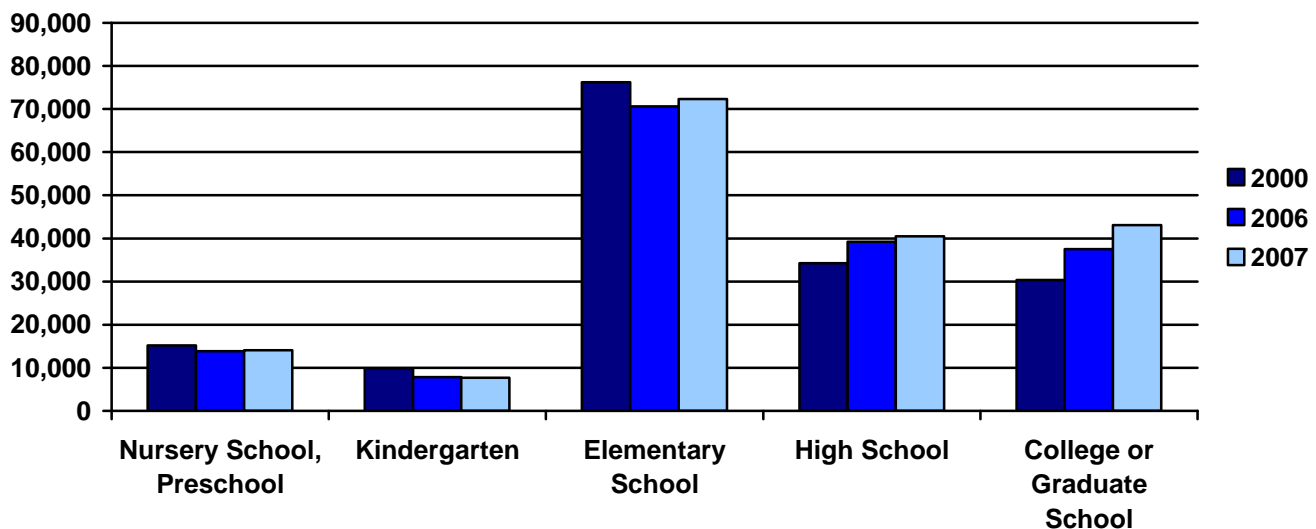

There are wide differences in poverty rates among the school districts in Monmouth County. Elementary School Academic Achievement

The New Jersey Assessment of Skills and Knowledge (NJASK) is the statewide assessment designed to measure student progress in the attainment of the Core Curriculum Content Standards⁴ in the areas of language arts, math and science. The total scores will be reported in one of three proficiency levels: Advanced Proficient (pass), Proficient (pass), or Partially Proficient (fail). Scores that fall in the Partially Proficient level indicate that the student has not met the minimum level of proficiency required. Figures 24, 25 and 26 depict the NJASK scores for fourth grade in Monmouth County Primary, Elementary and Charter schools.

The High School Proficiency Assessment (HSPA) is used to determine student achievement in reading, writing, and mathematics as specified in the New Jersey Core Curriculum Content Standards. The total scores will be reported in one of three proficiency levels: Advanced Proficient (pass), Proficient (pass), or Partially Proficient (fail). Scores that fall in the Partially Proficient level indicate that the student has not met the minimum level of proficiency required. Figures 27, 28 and 29 depict academic performance for the HSPA by school district.
